How to get to the venue?

From Marseille Vieux-Port or City Center, you can either:

1. Take a Taxi : Taxi “Masoni” +33 6 22 65 45 85 (Cars and mini-bus available)
or Taxi with meter - *Please avoid non official Taxi*

2. Take the subway: Line 1 to the direction of “La Rose”

When arriving at La Rose Subway station, take the bus line 1 (to the direction of Chateau-Gombert) and step out the bus at the stop “Einstein Parking Relais”

Please Note: Cybernetix Gate is located next to the bus stop

From Marignane Airport, you can either:

1. Take a Taxi : Taxi “Masoni” +33 6 22 65 45 85 (Cars and mini-bus available)
or Taxi with Meter outside airport from dedicated Taxi Rank
